#### SELECTION PROCESS AND PAYMENT

Applications for the AMEC scholarship will close on 15 August 2026 and offer/s will be made by late August 2026. The decision on scholarship offer/s to students will be made by a Selection Panel of Executives from AMEC. The decision of the Selection Panel will be final.

Payment of the scholarship will be to the nominated amount on the scholarship offer directly to the scholarship recipient. Payment will be made to the student's nominated Australian bank account following the provision of proof of purchase as approved by AMEC.
